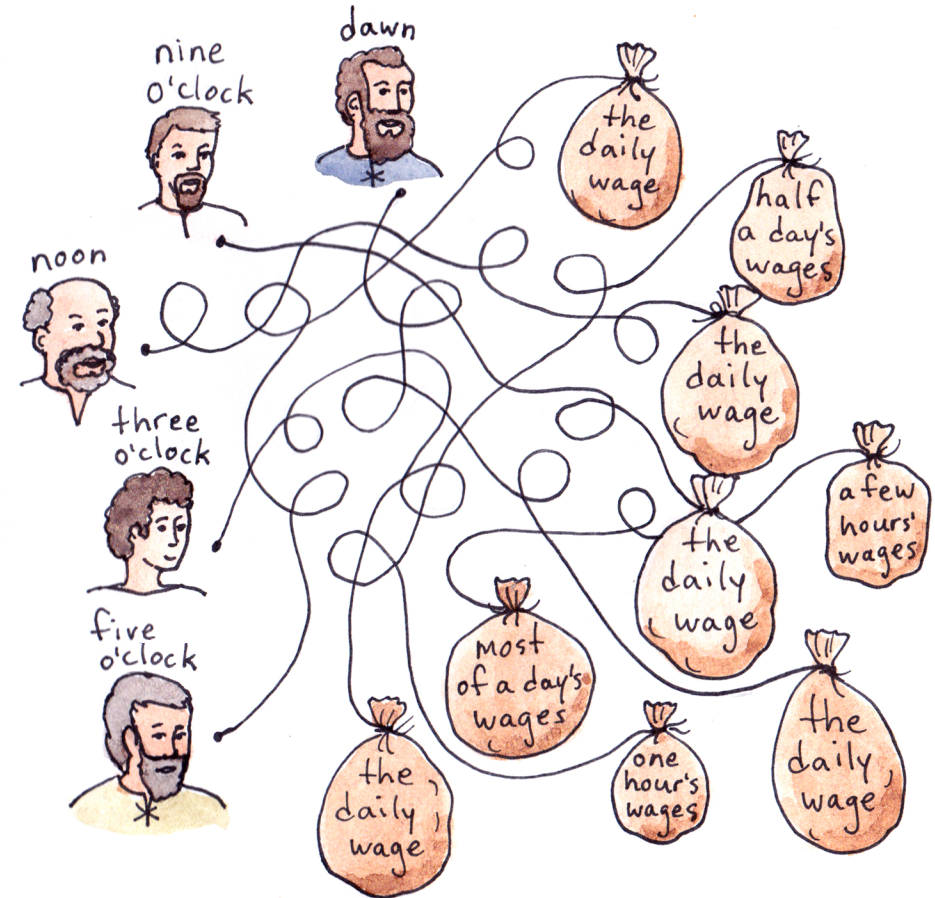

In the parable in today's Gospel reading, Jesus tells the story of a man with a vineyard who went out to hire men at different times of the day.

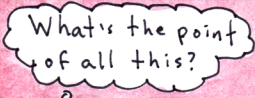

Inside page- Christ.

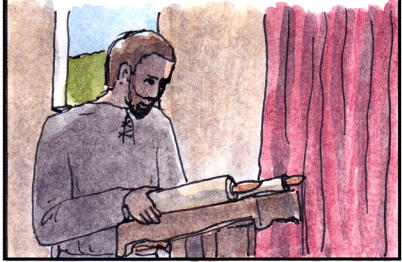
Saint Jerome
