Redemptor Hominis: Love Has a Name

The God of creation is revealed as the God of redemption, as the God who is "faithful to himself" and faithful to his love for the man and the world, which he revealed on the day of creation. His is a love that does not draw back before anything that justice requires in him. Therefore "for our sake (God) made him (the Son) to be sin who knew no sin." If he "made to be sin" him who was without any sin whatever, it was to reveal the love that is always greater than the whole of creation, the love that is he himself, since "God is love." Above all, love is greater than sin, than weakness, than the "futility of creation", it is stronger than death; it is a love that is always ready to raise up and forgive, always ready to go to meet the prodigal son, always looking for "the revealing of the sons of God", who are called to the glory that is to be revealed. This revelation of love and mercy has taken a form and a name: that of Jesus Christ.
