**2018 SYNOD OF BISHOPS:
YOUNG PEOPLE, THE FAITH AND
VOCATIONAL DISCERNMENT**

In January of this year, Pope Francis called for a Synod of Bishops to take place in October of 2018 on the topic of “Young People, the Faith, and Vocational Discernment”. All dioceses, including the Archdiocese of Toronto, have been asked by the Holy Father to provide input which will be used to help draft the **Instrumentum Laboris**, the working paper for the Synod participants. In order to provide the most accurate and valuable input to the Vatican, we are turning to the young people, and those who work with young people, throughout the Archdiocese of Toronto to gather your thoughts on this subject matter. Your participation in this project is greatly appreciated and we will take all of the input that we receive, collate it, and submit all of our findings to the Vatican.
